



Signage Installation Guide and Care

Ensure the surface, on which the sign has to be installed is clean. It should be free from dust, oil, or any other surface contaminants.

Mark the position where the sign has to be installed. Ensure that the height is not less than 1300 mm and not more than 1700 mm above the floor level.

Use a spirit level to make sure that you have the correct sign level, location and orientation before installing sign, removal will most likely damage paintwork.

Use the Double Sided Bonding Tape or screws (if hardware variant purchased) provided with the sign to fix it to the surface.

Install using double sided bonding tape

Remove release liner from tape to fix the sign to the surface. To ensure firm adhesion, once the sign is in place apply pressure with a bang on the area that the tape is applied a couple of times with the side of your fist or a firm push to activate the adhesive. The adhesive may fail if you do not apply pressure and just stick it on the wall.

Install using screws

Use a 6mm hammer drill for brick or concrete surface and a 2mm standard drill for wooden surfaces, to make the holes. Use a plastic sleeve/gitti provided with the sign and insert it into the holes made with 6mm hammer drill, wooden surface doesn't need to insert plastic sleeve/gitti.

Cleaning & Maintenance of the Sign

Use warm soapy water first and then if necessary glass cleaner.

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
